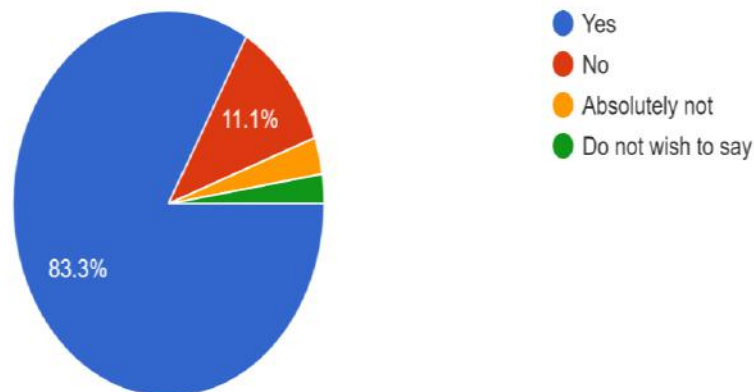

Does the college provide you guidance about choosing your course or subject during the admission process?

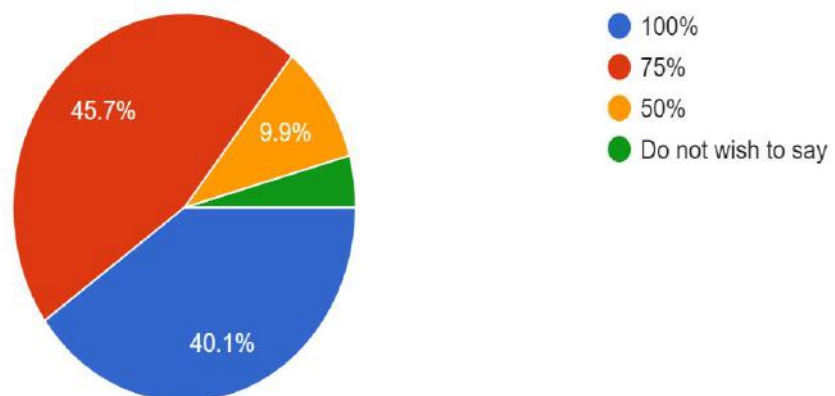

How useful / effective do you think your degree will be after your graduation?

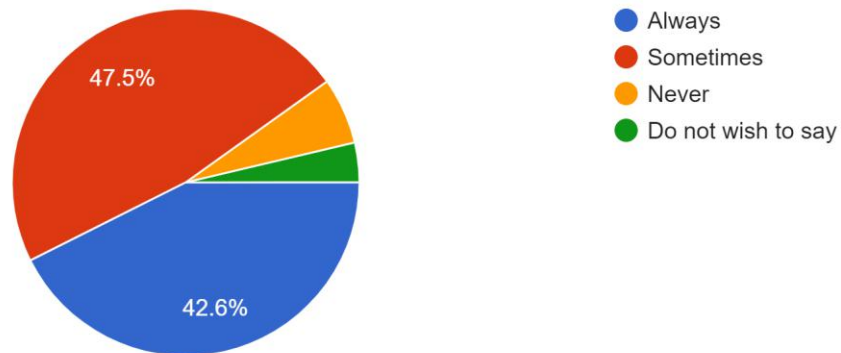

Your teachers use the latest methods and technology while teaching in the class.....

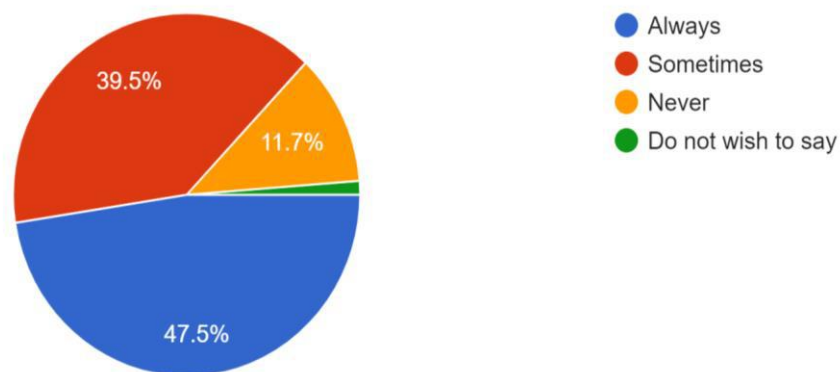

Does your college provide information and counselling about career and placements?

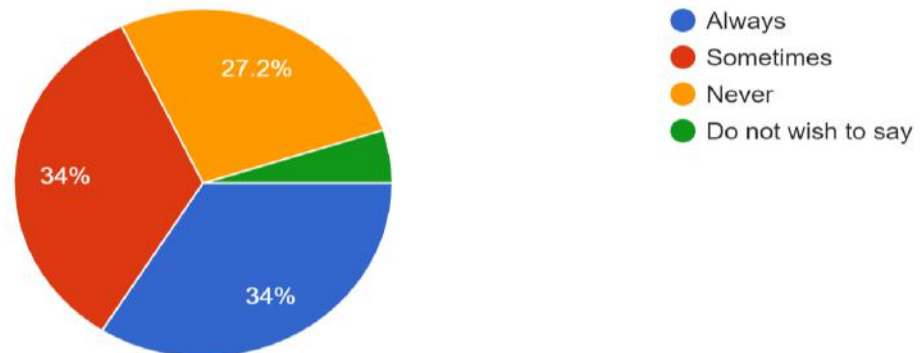

The College organizes study tours under various subject departments...

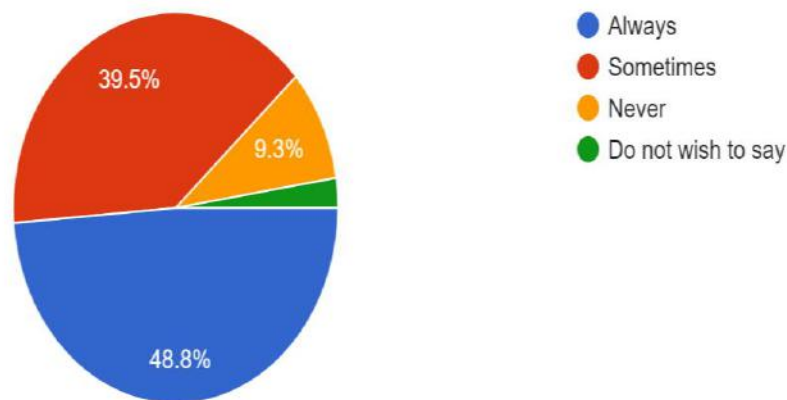

The College provides you information and guidance about Scholarships and other facilities...

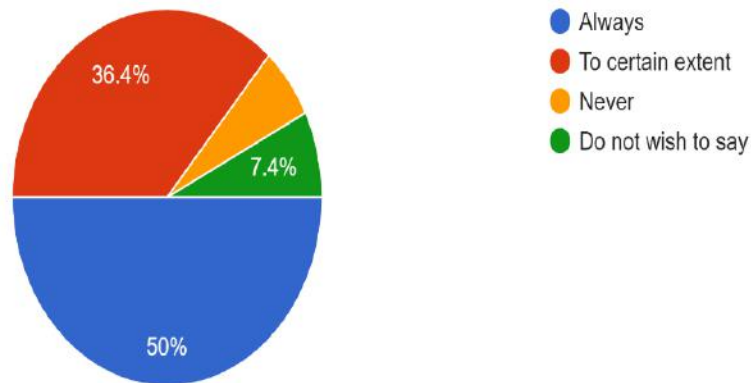

The College tries to bring about holistic/ overall personality development among students through co- curricular activities....

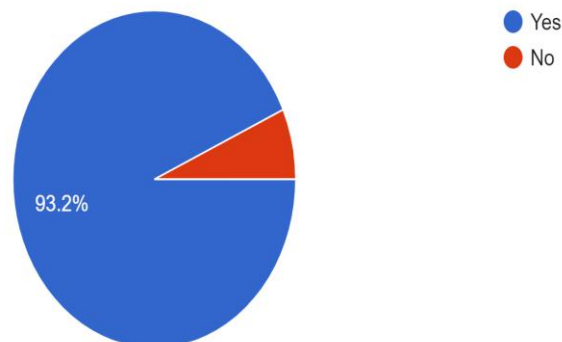
