
Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) Analysis Report (2017-2018)




The summary is presented on the college website. The response given by the students for questionnaire are demonstrated with pie chart as given below.




The above chart indicates that maximum number of students responded yes i.e. 85 % and 15% percentage responded number.




In the above chart it is clearly seen that the college do provide guidance while choosing course or subject during the admission process. Majority of the students that is 63% felt yes.




This chart represents that 60 % students responded that degree is effective after completion of graduation.




The chart indicates that the teachers had completed 70% of syllabus in every semester.




As per the above chart it is clearly seen that 72% students feels that teachers used latest methods and technology while teaching in class.




This chart indicates that 57% of the evaluation of the Internal Assessment Test in your college is fair.




The above chart indicates that 50 % of the respondent felt that value addition courses under the COP course provided by the college.
