The seminar started with an introduction of the college followed by welcome note. Later the speaker elucidated about contents of research paper. The overall seminar was on components of research paper.

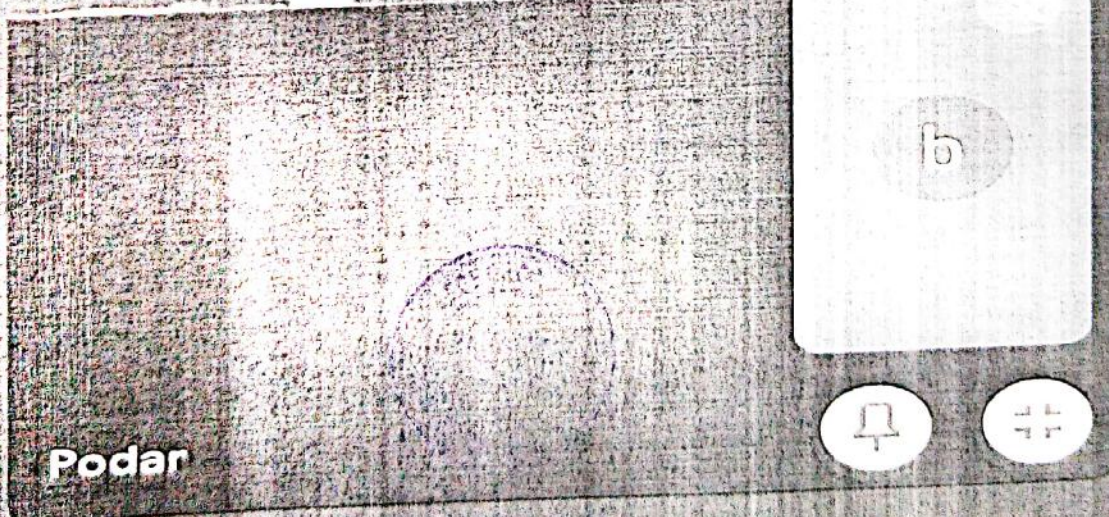
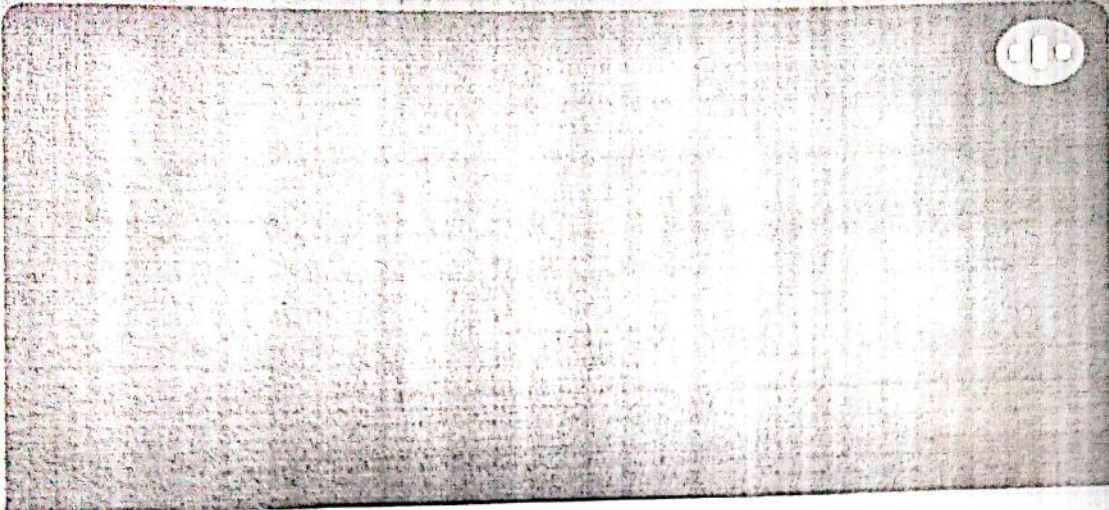

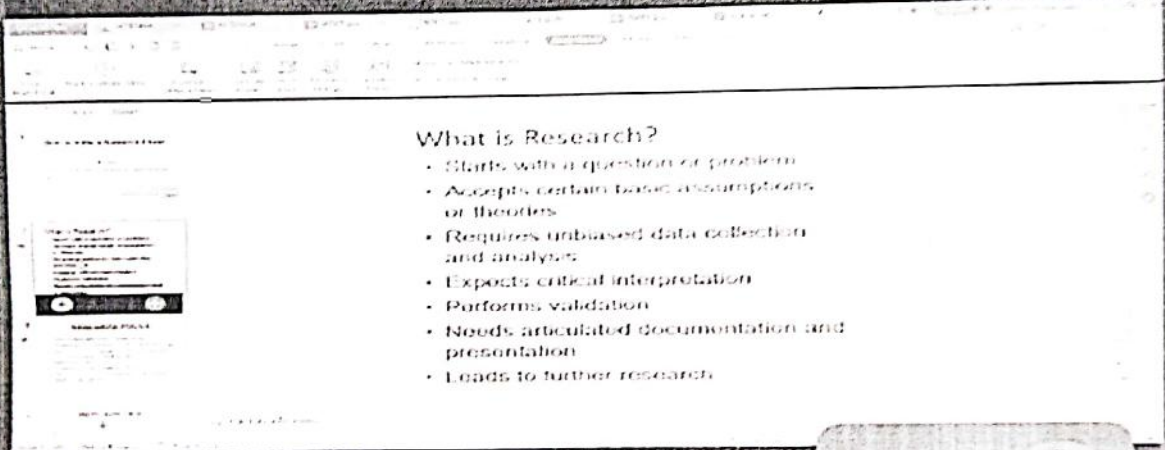
