3. Education for All: Gandhi's Vision



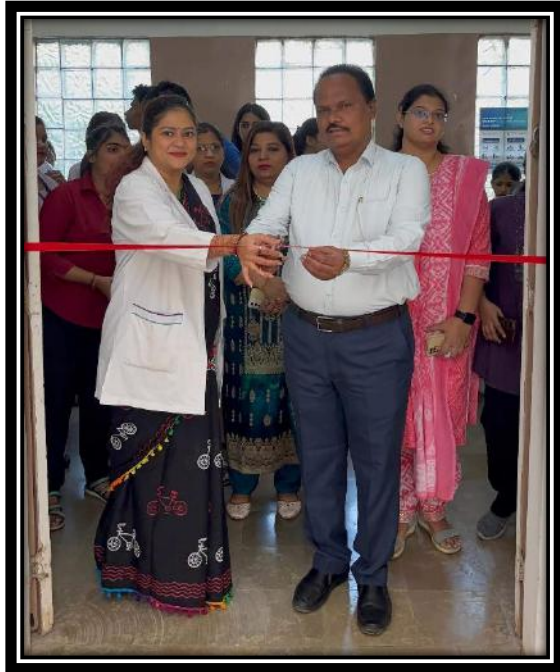
FIRST TERM TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR STUDENTS

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

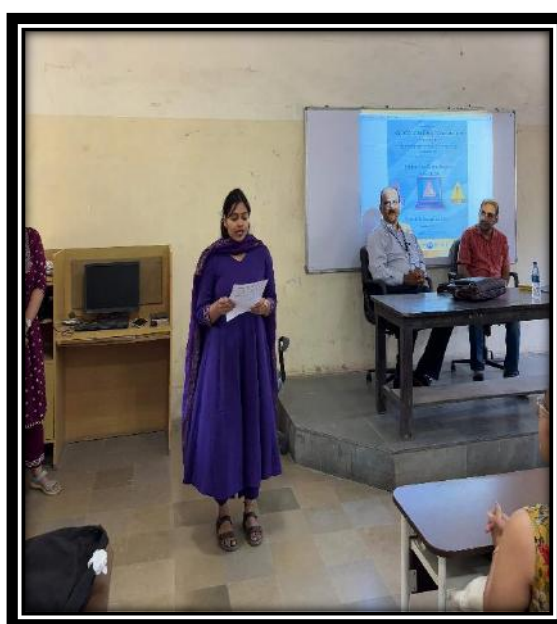

SEMINAR ON CYBER SECURITY AWARENESS

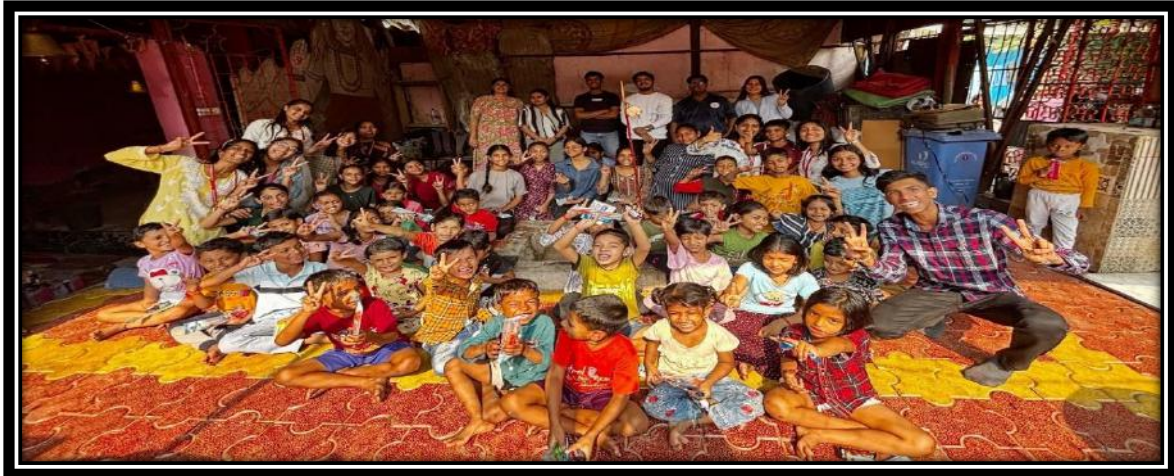

Chief Manager Mr. Vishal Bandekar from Indian bank, was the keynote speaker for the seminar.



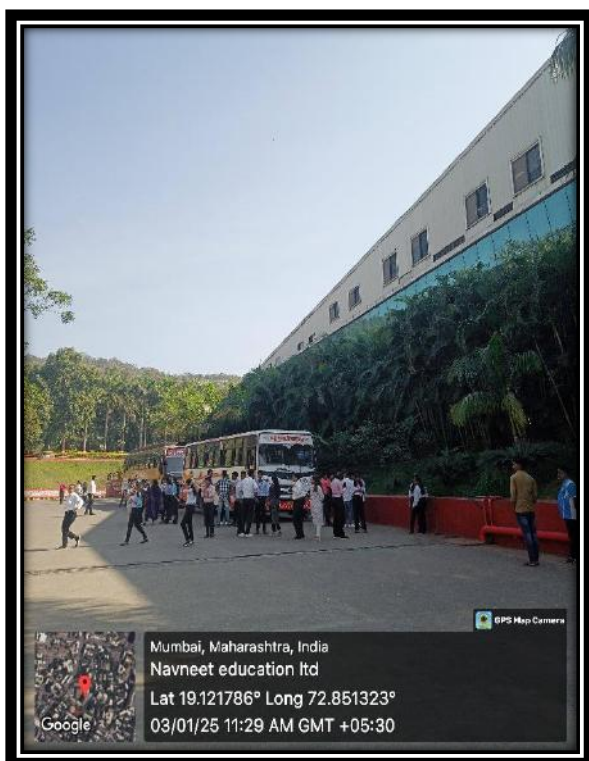
VISIT TO SLUM AREA TO INTERACT WITH CHILDREN
