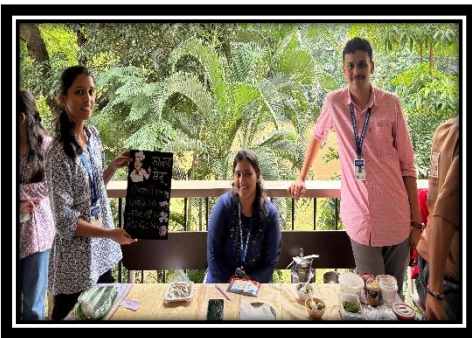
RAKSHABANDHAN CELEBRATION WITH RPF & GRPF STAFF
